Our Environment for Dementia Care...

We have created an environment at La Fontana which benefits people with dementia, their families and carers.

Families can explore the window displays of our hardware store, chocolate maker, minimarket and antiques shop as they head together for the beach in our sun room. An ice cream served from the vintage cart is a real treat to enjoy here, whilst relaxing alongside the colourful beach huts and seaside panorama under a blue summer sky.

Out through the sun room doors lays a beach themed area of the garden with a rowing boat and lobster pots, providing a natural link to the rest of the grounds.

Our gardens have been designed and landscaped to help people with dementia maintain their connection with the outdoors. Each area provides visual interest to encourage spontaneity and interaction with the environment as well as places to relax quietly or socialise in. We have maintained the link with our rural setting through our paddock of alpacas and petting farm complete with vintage tractor.

Those who have always enjoyed gardening can keep involved with the activity in our greenhouses and raised beds or just enjoy the results!
